Source: Goat

General description: Goat polyclonal antibody to Albumin. Albumin is a soluble, monomeric, globular unglycosylated serum protein of 66 kDa. This protein comprises about one-half of the blood serum protein. It has a role in stabilizing extracellular fluid volume and is a carrier protein for fatty acids and steroids

Alternative names: ALB, ANALBA, FDAH, PRO0883, PRO0903 and PRO1341 antibody.

Form: Polyclonal antibody supplied as a 200 µl (3 mg/ml) aliquot in PBS, 20% glycerol and 0.05% sodium azide. This antibody is epitope-affinity purified from goat antiserum.

Immunogen: Purified full length native Albumin.

Specificity: Using serum samples detects a band around 66 kDa by Western blot.

Reactivity: Reacts with Human, Rat, Mouse, Monkey and Canine proteins

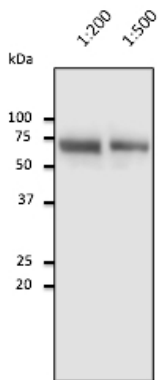

Usage:

WB: 1:500-1:5,000

Storage: For continuous use, store at 2-8 C for one-two days. For extended storage, store in -20 C freezer. Working dilution samples should be discarded if not used within 12 hours.

Special instructions: The antibody solution should be gently mixed before use..
