Source: Goat

General description: Goat polyclonal antibody to mCerulean (Cerulean fluorescent protein). mCerulean is a basic (constitutively fluorescent), monomeric engineered derivative of green fluorescent protein (GFP) isolated from *Aequorea victoria*. mCerulean is a ~27 kDa protein that is optimally excited at a 433 nm and has a maximum of emission at 575 nm. It is used in research as a reporter to label and study the biology of the cell using a wide range of applications.

Alternative names: green fluorescent protein antibody.

Form: Polyclonal antibody supplied as a 100 µl (3 mg/ml) aliquot in PBS, 20% glycerol and 0.05% sodium azide. This antibody is epitope-affinity purified from goat antiserum.

Immunogen: Purified recombinant fluorescent protein produced in *E. coli*.

Specificity: In 293HEK cells transfected with cds plasmid detects a band of 27 kDa by Western blot. This antibody does not recognize RFP (red fluorescent protein).

Reactivity: Reacts with Transfected cells proteins

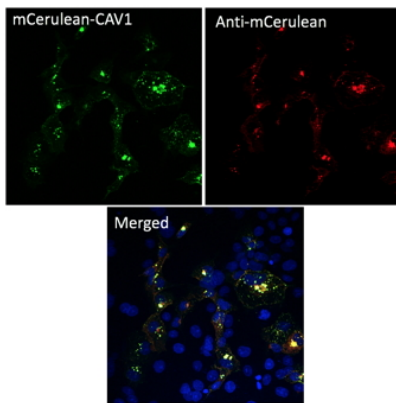

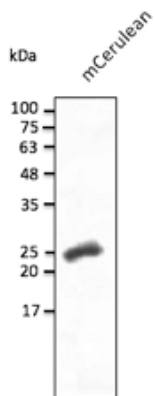
WB: 1:500-1:5,000
 IHC (F): 1:50-1:500
 IHC (P): 1:50-1:500
 IF: 1:50-1:500
 IEM: 1:50-1:500

Storage: For continuous use, store at 2-8 C for one-two days. For extended storage, store in -20 C freezer. Working dilution samples should be discarded if not used within 12 hours.

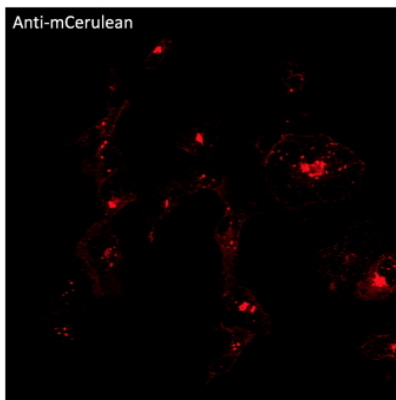
Special instructions: The antibody solution should be gently mixed before use..

Anti-mCerulean Ab at 1/2,500 dilution using HEK293 transfected cell lysates at 50 µg per lane; rabbit polyclonal to goat IgG (HRP) at 1/10,000 dilution;
